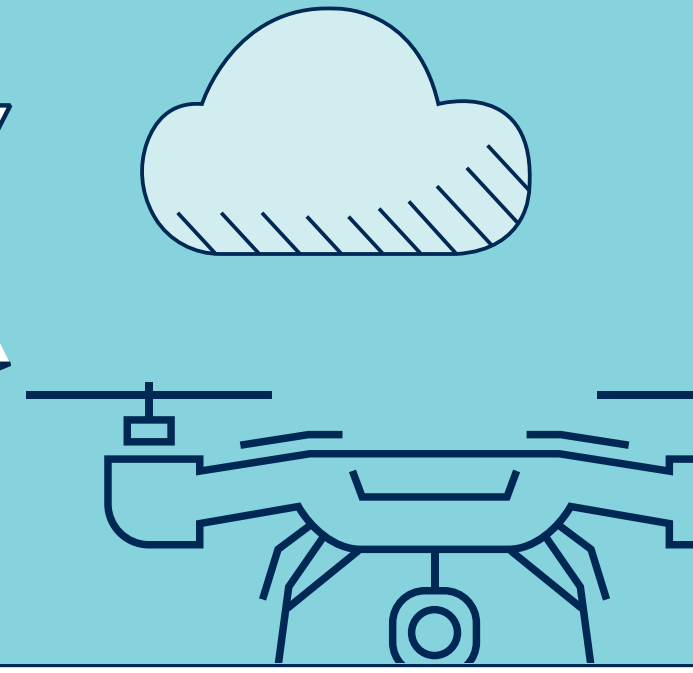
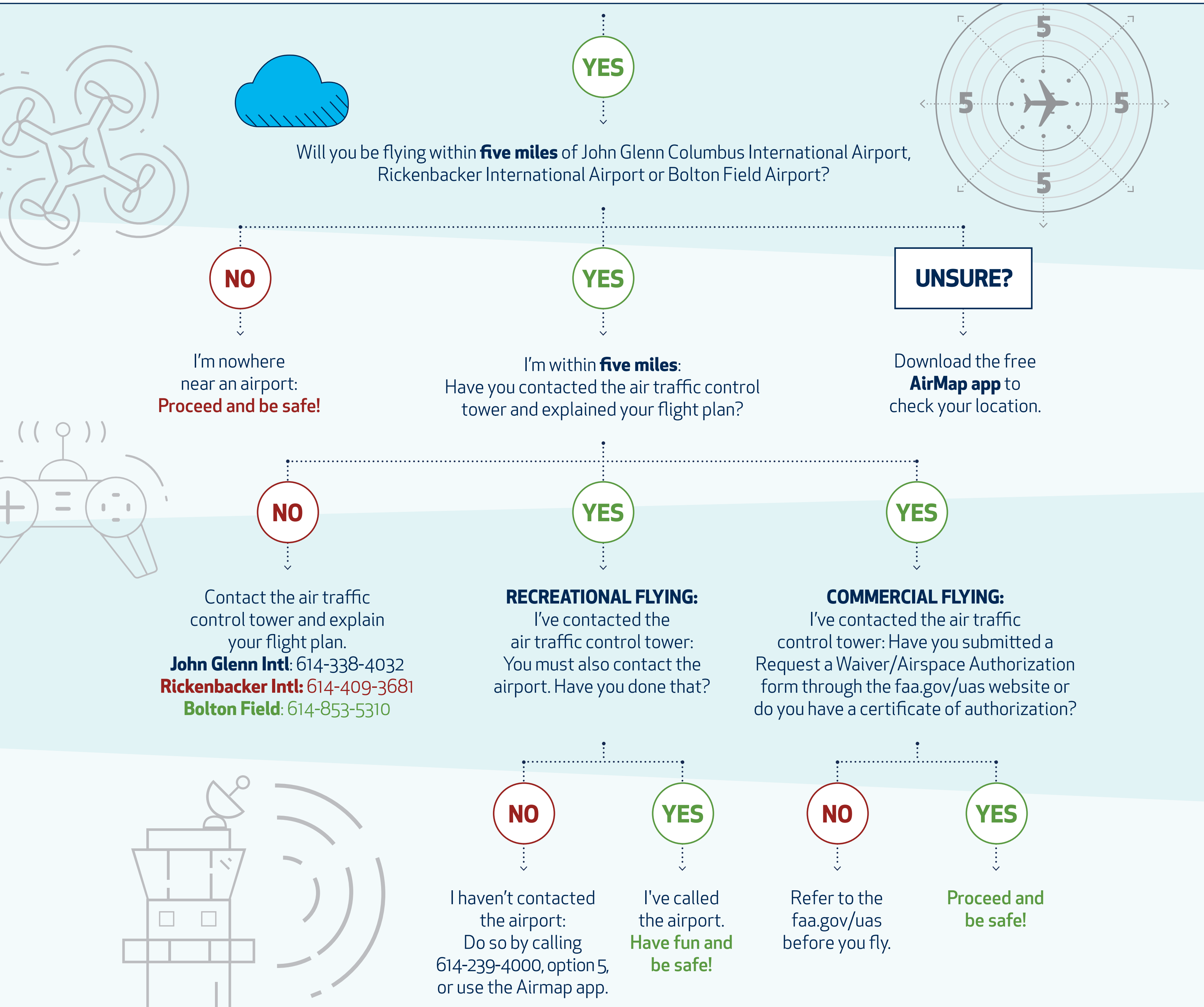

FLYING RECREATIONALLY OR COMMERCIALY?



REMEMBER THESE DRONE-FLYING BEST PRACTICES:

- Remain clear of and do not interfere with manned aircraft; always yield to manned aircraft
- Do not fly over 400 feet AGL
- Operate in daylight only
- Do not fly in adverse weather conditions (rain, wind, low visibility, etc.)
- Keep your drone in your visual line of sight
- Don't fly over people, other people's houses, military bases, stadiums, emergency response efforts or roads
- Download the free app B4UFLY and refer to FAA's operational rules known as Part 107
